# **Environmental charter of the Domaine de la TORTINIERE**

The Domaine de la Tortiniere has implemented an environmental approach to reduce its impact on the environment while maintaining its identity as a very comfortable hotel.

The Domaine has 25 rooms and 7 suites divided between the Château and the charming old pavilions close to the Château.

Our restaurant, both gastronomic and bistro, offers 70 seats and we also have small private rooms for family meals or small events.

We work with a team of 20 to 40 people depending on the time of the year, who we sensitize to the prevention of the environment and the respect of biodiversity because we are sensitive to it, given our environment in a magnificent natural park. Our young teams are also spontaneously very sensitive to these values.

Our clients are encouraged to respect their consumption of electricity, water and the park.

# For water:

Two speed toilets for flushing, leak repairs immediately.

Sign in bathrooms stating that linens will only be changed when guests place them in the tub.

Opportunity for guests to opt out of room cleaning service.

Flow restrictors in showerheads and sinks.

## For electricity:

Use of LED bulbs throughout the Domain (rooms, restaurant, kitchen, common areas, exterior). Installation of motion detectors and timers for exterior lighting and corridors More than 75% of the windows are double glazed.

## Personal care products:

All our rooms are equipped with soap/shampoo dispensers and all reception products are COSMECERT certified.

## Cleaning products:

We only use ECOLABELLED products for cleaning the rooms, restaurant, kitchen and all common areas.

## For the park:

We make compost with green waste and we replant trees (local species) every year to replace those that fall.

# **Activities:**

We offer our guests environmentally friendly activities such as bike rental, a boat ride on the Indre River.

We favor non-polluting modes of transportation thanks to our 2 electric charging stations and our proximity to a bus line for the center of Tours.
